A free mobile viewing app available for Android and iOS-based mobile devices gives users the ability to view live video from cameras as well as previously recorded video footage.

AXIS Camera Station 5 allows users to take full advantage of Axis' wide range of video surveillance cameras and technologies. It supports 360° overview recording, H.264 compression, multi-view streaming, Axis' Corridor Format, Axis' Zipstream technology and advanced camera-based video motion detection.
