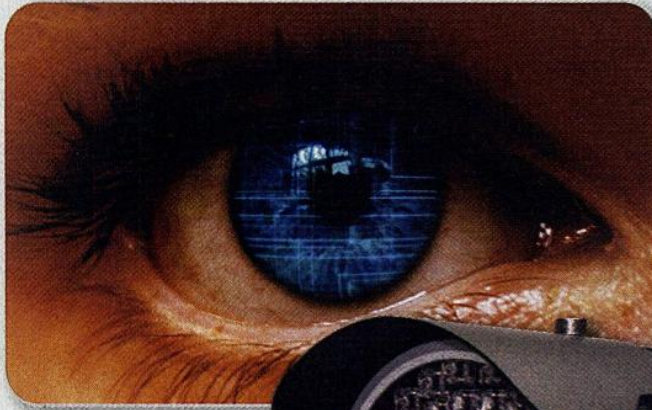


## Security make-over with TechSmart's security tips



### Maxcam Vari Focal 40m IR Long Distance Camera

This high quality camera features an adjustable external lens that can be adjusted to focus from between 25m and 40m. In order to obtain uniform lighting infrared (IR) LEDs are placed at various angles, ensuring the optimum viewing angle.

A removable IR cut filter is built-in, allowing accurate focus for both day and night. This camera features a double glass window that reduces internal reflection back into the camera. These types of cameras are prone to overheating, but the Maxcam deals effectively with heat dissipation by having a solid Aluminium alloy housing, that is also weatherproof.

### Axis 207W

The 207W is a neat wireless surveillance device weighing 177g. This makes it easy to position and ideal for mounting. The camera comes with two swivel mount options. A pedestal mount and a clamp mount. This particular model is only suitable for indoor use.

The Axis boasts a 1/4 inch progressive scan RGB CMOS image sensor and a 4mm lens. What this translates to is excellent image quality. The image sensor has remarkable low-light functionality, said to be effective down to 1 lux. It's RRP is **R2900**. Contact Axis for more info on 011-548-6780.

### Maxcam 1/3" 3.6mm Dome Camera

Maxcam dome cameras are versatile, very easy to mount and don't present an obtrusive eyesore to people in your shop, home or business. They are mountable on ceilings or walls and feature an electronic iris, as well as auto white balance. The unit we tested has a 1/3" Sony CCD (imaging sensor) and a 3.6mm lens. The units are also available with 2.8mm, 6mm and 8mm lenses. Eurobyte (011-234-0142) also offer a range of vandal proof dome cameras for use in high traffic areas or where there exists the possibility that people might tamper with camera fixtures. It's RRP is **R682**.



### Maxcam 15m Infrared 6mm Camera

This camera can film up to a distance of 15 metres and achieves very good picture clarity, in colour, through its 1/3" Sony CCD. This size works very well for day and night outdoor surveillance applications.

The camera uses zero-lux imaging, meaning that it needs no external light source in order to operate properly. The 6 IR illuminators ensure high-quality monochrome images in total darkness from as far away as 15 meters. Like the 40m camera this camera is water-resistant and has a very durable aluminium alloy construction. It's RRP is **R1024**.
