Newbury Street

Faneuil Hall

Located in the heart of downtown Boston, Faneuil Hall Marketplace is adjacent to historic Faneuil Hall and is bordered by the financial district, the waterfront, the North End, Government Center and Haymarket. It is a well-traveled part of Boston's "Freedom Trail". The Marketplace is a 5-minute walk to the New England Aquarium, The Children's Museum, The Old State House, and Paul Revere's House. Other nearby attractions include the New State House, The Museum of Fine Arts, Boston Public Garden, Old North Church, The USS Constitution and Fenway Park, among others.
