Respond to incidents quickly and effectively

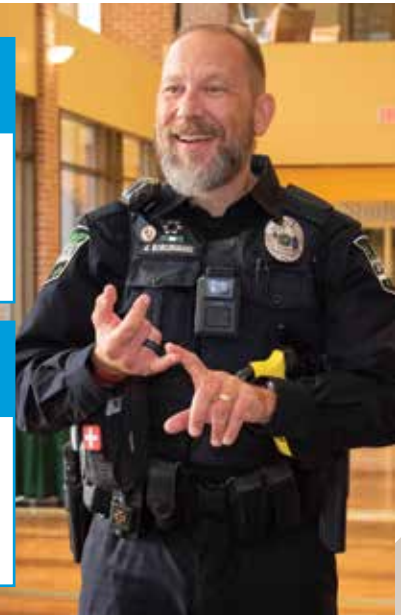
Be able to resolve conflicts, disruptive behavior, or threats of violence, and respond to these interactions with composure, authority, and respect for all parties involved.

Intercom and communication systems

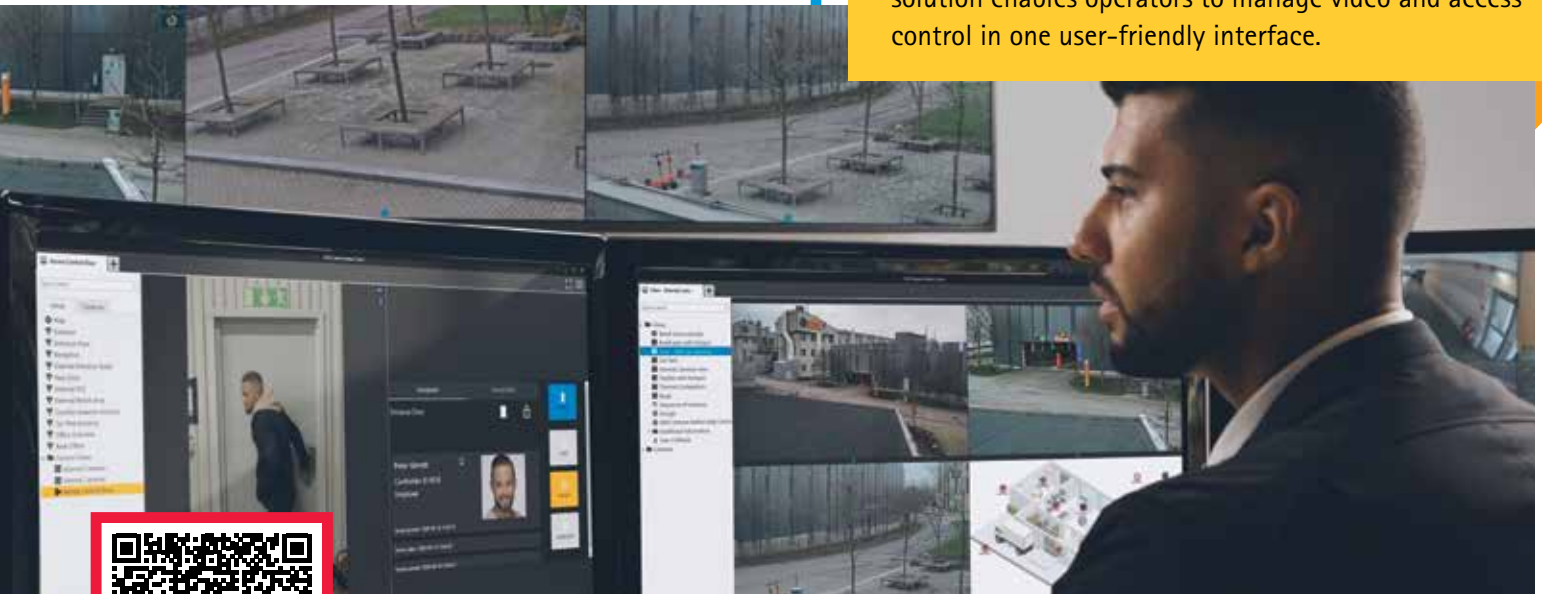
