Currency


The official currency in Sweden is the Swedish Krona (SEK). Cash machines are commonly available, and credit cards are accepted at most vendors, including shops, restaurants, taxis, and parking garages.

The country prefix for Sweden is +46. Calling the Axis office within Sweden is done by dialing 046 272 1800. Please remember that roaming charges may apply. For correct pricing and dialing information at the hotel, contact the front desk.









Directions

By air

Copenhagen Airport (CPH)

The closest international airport is Copenhagen Airport located in Copenhagen, Denmark, which is approximately a 45-minute drive to the Axis office. This airport serves most parts of the world with direct flights.

The airport is located directly by the bridge to Sweden and with motorway connections to central Copenhagen and Malmö/Lund. Our recommendation for travel is to take the Öresundtåg train to either Malmö or Lund and then taxi to the office. Please note that there might be a passport control when crossing the Danish/Swedish border. From Copenhagen airport to Axis office, a car from our preferred taxi company, Taxi Malmö, needs to be booked in advance. The cost is approx 1100 SEK one way.

Malmö Airport (MMX)

The nearest Swedish airport is Malmö-Sturup Airport which has good domestic connections to Stockholm, and a few international connections.

Guests arriving at the airport going directly to Axis in Lund are recommended to use a taxi from our preferred company, Taxi Malmö. The cost is approximately 450 SEK one way.

By train/public transport

The most convenient way to purchase tickets and get useful traffic information when traveling with the local public transport company, Skånetrafiken, is to download the Skånetrafiken app to your mobile phone.

Lund Central Station is located approximately 8-10 minutes from the Axis Headquarters by taxi, local bus, or tram. You can choose to go by local bus to bus stop "Lund Ideon Gateway" or by tram to station "Lund Ideontorget" which is just a short walk to the Axis Headquarters.

A single ticket can be purchased by holding your credit card against the card reader when entering the tram or bus. Or use the Skånetrafiken app to buy and activate your ticket before boarding.

By car

Axis Headquarters is located directly by the E22 motorway next to the exit "Lund Norra". Take the exit and drive towards Lund city and turn left in the upcoming roundabouts.

Follow the signs and you will find the Axis main building and reception at the end of the street at Gränden 1, Lund.

Parking

Axis offers parking, designated for guests only, directly by the main building. This will allow you to park for free during your visit.




All taxis in Sweden are licensed. This means that (1) the vehicle will have yellow license plates instead of normal white ones, (2) the driver should have his/her taxi driver's license visible on the dashboard and (3) all rates should be published and easily readable from outside the vehicle. To compare the meter price of different companies, all companies should show a comparison price, which indicates a typical journey according to Swedish Transport Regulation regarding taxi carriers. It is advisable to avoid companies showing a very high comparison price.

These taxi companies will also accept major credit cards as payment for the trip. To avoid waiting time, especially during rush hours, we recommend prebooking your taxi if possible.

Contact the reception at Axis Headquarters or at your hotel if you need help booking a taxi.

A premium boutique hotel with a well-known restaurant and bar in the absolute city center with Malmö's nightlife just around the corner. Offers gym and sauna.





Things to do

Lund

With cobblestones and half-timbered houses, Lund is a medieval city that blends in with modern buildings and innovative environments. So, if you have time before or after your business in Lund, we recommend you take the opportunity to visit some of the sites the area has to offer.

Lund Cathedral (Lunds Domkyrka)

1,000 years old, and with more than 700,000 people visiting every year, Lund Cathedral is one of the ten most popular places to visit in Lund. The cathedral offers many exciting stories inside and outside the walls.

Lund University - main building

After your visit at the cathedral, take a short walk to the other side of the park named Lundagård. Here you will find the main building of Lund University. Built in 1882, this majestic building is inspired by the columns and arches of Rome and ancient Greece, and is one of the most iconic buildings in Lund.

Malmöhus Castle (Malmöhus slott)

Malmöhus Castle is Scandinavia's oldest surviving renaissance-era castle. Constructed in 1434 and finally completed in the 1500s, it was one of the residences of the Danish Royal Family, later becoming a prison. Today Malmöhus houses the City Museum of Malmö.

Turning Torso

North to south from Stortorget to Gustav Adolfs Torg is the main shopping artery, and one of Malmö's oldest streets. It passes through all the city squares, and in 1978 it became Malmö's first pedestrianized street.
