> By Airport Express

The Airport Express takes passengers to Central in just 24 minutes. Quick and comfortable, trains depart at about 10-minute intervals from 05:54 to 23:28 and approximately 12-minute intervals from 23:28 to 00:48 daily. Passengers taking the Airport Express can enjoy the free In-town Check-in service in Hong Kong and Kowloon Stations to check in between 90 minutes and one full day ahead of their scheduled flight departure time. Please contact your respective airlines for further information.

> By taxi

Taxis are regulated, safe, and widely available in Hong Kong. Please note the following:

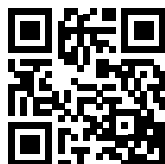
- > Taxis accept cash only - no credit cards
- > Special taxi queues for travel between Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and Lantau Island - additional toll charges apply
- > Taxi from airport to hotel is approximately HK\$350 (including toll charges)
- > Not all drivers speak English - bring your Chinese address (e.g. hotel or office) with you to show the driver

Hotel accommodations

Below are recommended hotels closer to Axis office at the East Kowloon area:

- > Crowne Plaza Hong Kong Kowloon East at Tseung Kwan O (20-30min by taxi to Axis office)
- > L' Hotel elan at Kwun Tong (15 min by taxi to Axis office)
- > CAMLUX (10 min by walk or shuttle bus to Exchange Tower which is 5 min walk from Axis office)

Directions to Axis

You can travel to our Hong Kong office with taxi or MTR (metro line).

- > MTR operates a domestic railway network covering 91 stations on 10 main commuter lines: Kwun Tong, Tsuen Wan, Island, South Island, Tung Chung, Tseung Kwan O, East Rail, West Rail, Ma On Shan and Disneyland Resort lines. Step off at the Kowloon Bay station on Kwun Tong Line, and then take a 15-min walk to the office.
- > For visitors to Axis Experience Center, Hong Kong, who are staying at Crowne Plaza Hotel, free shuttle bus is available at 0745, 0800, 0815 from hotel to Enterprise Square Tower 1.

A landmark from the Age of Steam and a reminder of Hong Kong's colonial heritage.

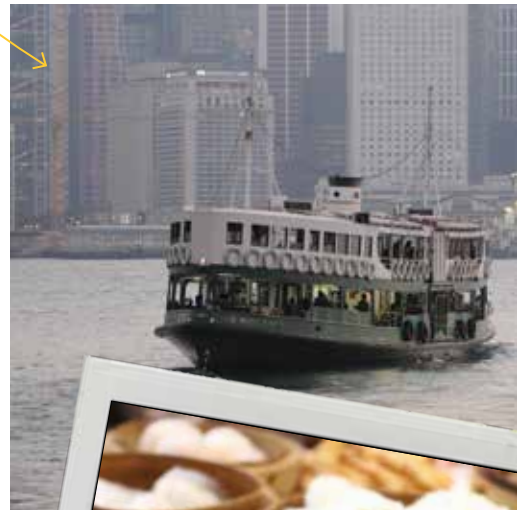
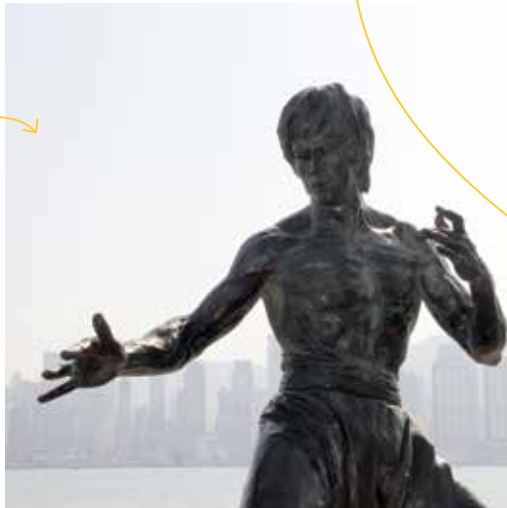
Star Ferry
