About Axis

Axis Communications was formally founded 1984 by Mikael Karlsson, Martin Gren and Keith Bloodworth. The year before, Martin Gren and Mikael Karlsson founded the company Gren & Karlsson Firmware. With Mikael's knowledge and understanding of International Business, Martin's technical expertise and Keith's skills in sales models they formed a complementary and dynamic combination. By the end of the 1980s Axis had established a position as one of the three world leaders in protocol converters/printer interfaces.

With the emergence of new technologies and the growing importance of network accessibility, Axis broadened its connectivity scope to include solutions for network printing and document management in wired and wireless environments. In response to the convergence towards IP-based systems, Axis also focused increasingly on applications for video surveillance, remote monitoring, and web broadcasting, and introduced the world's first network camera in 1996.

Currency

The official currency in the United Kingdom is Sterling (GBP). Cash machines are commonly available, and credit cards are accepted at most vendors, including shops, restaurants, taxis and parking garages.

Dialing in the UK

The country prefix for the United Kingdom is +44. Using your mobile phone to dial a British number is done by dialing the number including (0). Calling the Axis UK office is done by dialing 01582 283 760. Dialing internationally is done by typing the country code prior to number, i.e. +44 1582 283 760. Please remember that roaming charges apply, and even a short call may be very costly.

Directions to Axis

By air

London Luton Airport (LLA)

The closest international airport is London Luton Airport, which is approximately a 5-minute drive to the Axis office. This airport serves most parts of the world with direct flights.

More info can be found on: www.london-luton.co.uk. We recommend that you take a taxi to the office. Cost for a taxi from the airport to Capability Green (CG1) is £10.

By train

The closest train station is Luton Airport Parkway, which is 5 minutes by taxi to the office. You will find good connections to most parts of the United Kingdom, and regular direct trains to/from London St Pancras Station. Information about local trains: <https://tfl.gov.uk/>

By car

The Axis office is 1.5 miles from Junction 10 on the M1.

From the South

Head north on Exit 10. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto New Airport Way/A1081. Take the exit towards Capability Green. At the roundabout take the 1st exit. Turn left. Destination will be on the left.

From the North

Head south-east on Exit 10. Keep left, follow signs for Luton/Airport/A1081. Slight left onto New Airport Way/A1081. Take the exit. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit. Turn left. Destination will be on the left.

Please note: For Sat Nav users Please use the address 1 Capability Green, not the post code.

By Uber

If you have the app on your phone, Ubers are frequent drivers in the area and cheaper than a Taxi. An Uber is also recommended if you are travelling from any other airport further away than Luton Airport. An Uber from Luton Airport to the office will approximately cost £6.
