Classification Information:

Thermal Cameras operating at a frame rate ≤ 9 fps are not controlled for export under European Commission Customs legislations unless exported to Embargoed and Sanctioned Countries. Additionally, they shall not be used in the design, development, production, or use of nuclear, chemical or biological weapons or missiles.

Permanent / Temporary Exports:

These products shall not be exported to Embargoed and Sanctioned Countries. Additionally, they shall not be used in the design, development, production, or use of nuclear, chemical or biological weapons or missiles.

Statement:
