

By air

The closest international Airport is **Munich Airport (MUC)**, called **Franz Joseph Strauß Airport**, located approximately 40 minutes from Munich city center and 20 minutes from the Axis office in Ismaning by train. The price for a one-way ticket to Munich city center is approximately 11€ and to Ismaning, approximately 8€. If you want to take the S-Bahn directly to the office, follow the green S-Bahn sign at the airport to the S-Bahn Station and take the **S8** towards "**Herrsching**" and exit in **Ismaning**. Take the exit at the back of the station. Outside go straight and then immediately take a right to **Mayerbacherstraße**. Then take the next left to **Adalperostraße** and walk until you reach number 86.

By train

The closest train station to Ismaning is Munich Central Station (München Hauptbahnhof). From there you can take the S-Bahn **S8** towards the **Airport**. Exit at the station **Ismaning** and take the exit at the front and go up the stairs. Go straight and then immediately take a right to **Mayerbacherstraße**. Then take the next left to **Adalperostraße** and walk until you reach number 86.

By car

When coming from motorway A9: While driving on **A9**, take the exit **Garching Süd** and stay on **B471** heading toward Feldkirchen/Erding/Ismaning/Garching. After 450 m make a left turn; staying on **B471**. After 4.4 km turn right onto **Osterfeldstraße**. After 400 m, head straight through the traffic circle (2nd exit) to **Adalperostraße**. The Axis office is number 86 and offers various parking possibilities.

By taxi

If you would like to take a taxi to the Axis office in Ismaning, you can take all available taxis from the airport or train station, or you can call a taxi: Taxi München at +49 (0)89 21 610, or Feringa Taxi at +49 (0)89 900 68 780. All taxis in Germany use a taxi meter with fixed rates per kilometer that should be visible in the taxi. Many taxis offer the possibility to pay with credit card, but not all. If you want to be sure you have a taxi with this payment option, please mention it while ordering the taxi.

What to do in Munich?

Marienplatz and the New Town Hall of Munich

Marienplatz is the central square in the heart of Munich; from here you can explore many old and wonderful buildings, churches and landmarks. Marienplatz houses the Mariensäule, a column topped with the golden statue of Virgin Mary, and it is also home to the Old and the New Town Halls of Munich.

Frauenkirche Cathedral of Our Blessed Lady

The Catholic Cathedral of Our Blessed Lady is the landmark of Munich and the city's largest church; it holds up to 20,000 people. Together with the Town Hall, the sturdy twin towers of the Cathedral shape Munich's skyline and make it a great point of orientation. You can also climb the tower steps - the view of Munich's cityscape and the Bavarian Alps is breathtaking.

Deutsches Museum (German Museum)

The Deutsches Museum is located on an island in the river Isar that runs through Munich's city center. It is one of the oldest and largest science and technology museums in the world and boasts an impressive collection of historic artifacts.

The English Garden

Munich's largest park really shows the Munich lifestyle: a refreshing beer in the beer garden, sunbathing in the meadow, surfing on the Eisbach, a lot of culture and a splendid view over the city and the Alps.





Viktualienmarkt

Only a few steps away from Marienplatz, you can find the bustling Viktualienmarkt, Munich's daily outdoor farmer's market. Stroll past the 140 colorful booths and enjoy the unique flavor of this market that boasts a great variety of fresh, regional and exotic food

Museums Ensemble: Alte Pinakothek, Neue Pinakothek, Pinakothek der Moderne

West of the English Garden is a unique ensemble of three museums, each of them highlighting a different period in European art. The "Alte Pinakothek" is one of the oldest art galleries in the world and home to over 800 European masterpieces. The "Neue Pinakothek" features art and sculpture from the late 18th to the beginning of the 20th century. The "Pinakothek der Moderne" is the largest museum for modern art in Germany and spotlights art of the 20th century, including photography and video.

Der Alte Peter (Church of St. Peter)

The Church of St. Peter is one of Munich's landmarks, the oldest parish church in the city, and is known affectionately by locals as Alter Peter ("Old Peter"). The church stands on a hill called Petersbergl, which is the only noteworthy elevation within Munich's historic Old Town.

Schloss Nymphenburg (Nymphenburg Palace)

The Nymphenburg Palace west of Munich is one of the largest royal palaces in Europe. In 1664, Prince Ferdinand Maria had the castle built as a present to his wife, who had borne him the long-awaited heir, Max Emanuel. Among the highlights are the former bedroom of King Ludwig II and the impressive banquet hall with fine ceiling frescoes by Johann Baptist Zimmermann.

Residenz (Residence Palace of Munich)

At the edge of Munich's Old Town lies the Residence, the former royal palace of the Bavarian monarchs. Today the Residence houses one of the best European museums of interior decoration. The Residence, whose first buildings were constructed in 1385, consists of ten courtyards and beautiful historical gardens.



Olympiapark Olympic Stadium of Munich

This stadium was the site of the 1972 Summer Olympics, and its design was revolutionary and futuristic for its time: the sweeping and transparent canopies of acrylic glass that were modeled on the Alps are the signature characteristic of the Olympic Stadium.
